The names of **small towns in Scotland** are carried round the world mainly due to the Scotch Whisky **distilleries they house**. If it wasn't for the iconic cluster of white buildings located at Lagavulin on the south coast of Islay and also places like Dufftown (which is considered by some to be the 'Malt Whisky Capital of the World'), Scotland may not have the **global fame it has today**.

Great single malt whiskies are a combination of places and people. Without them, Scotch whisky as we know it may not exist as it is today. So, it feels right to celebrate not only the liquids but the traditions, people, folklore, myths and legends that make these towns magical.

This menu started as a bridging gap between the two most common ways to layout a whisky menu – regionality and the more contemporary approach of flavour exploration. Regionality is commonly used to categorize Scotch whisky because of general flavour profiles, however even within these regions, there are towns producing liquid that are exceptions to the rules.

With this in mind, we want to celebrate what makes these whisky towns great, and then talk about each whisky on its individual merit. Distilleries in this whisky menu are grouped by the town they are in or are nearest to.

If you're planning your next jaunt around Scotland, and need some inspiration, we would suggest taking your time and enjoying the stories. If you are here for flavour exploration you can skip straight to the flavour pages and find the right whisky for you. Within Dufftown, the 'main drag' leading towards the historical clock tower was once said to contain an illicit still, right under the nose of the excise men supposed to be finding such sites. Modern Dufftown is still host to six working distilleries and to some, can be considered the Malt Whisky Capital of the World. Not bad for a town with a population of just 1,667. Everyone you talk to whether it be in the shop, pub, ice cream shop or café will have a link to the whisky industry be it auntie, uncle, grandmother or grandfather.

This town was built on whisky and is home to some of the most adored and loved whisky brands around. It's easy to see why its name has travelled around the world.

Despite being a relative heavyweight in the distillery world, Elgin seems to get slightly less credit for its impressive amount of distilleries than little brother Dufftown. If you put distilleries to one side and consider the other great institutions of this once great Royal Burgh, you have Johnstons of Elgin producing fine wool since 1797 and the mighty Auld Mill Alpaca farm boasting over 80 Alpacas. Beat that Dufftown.

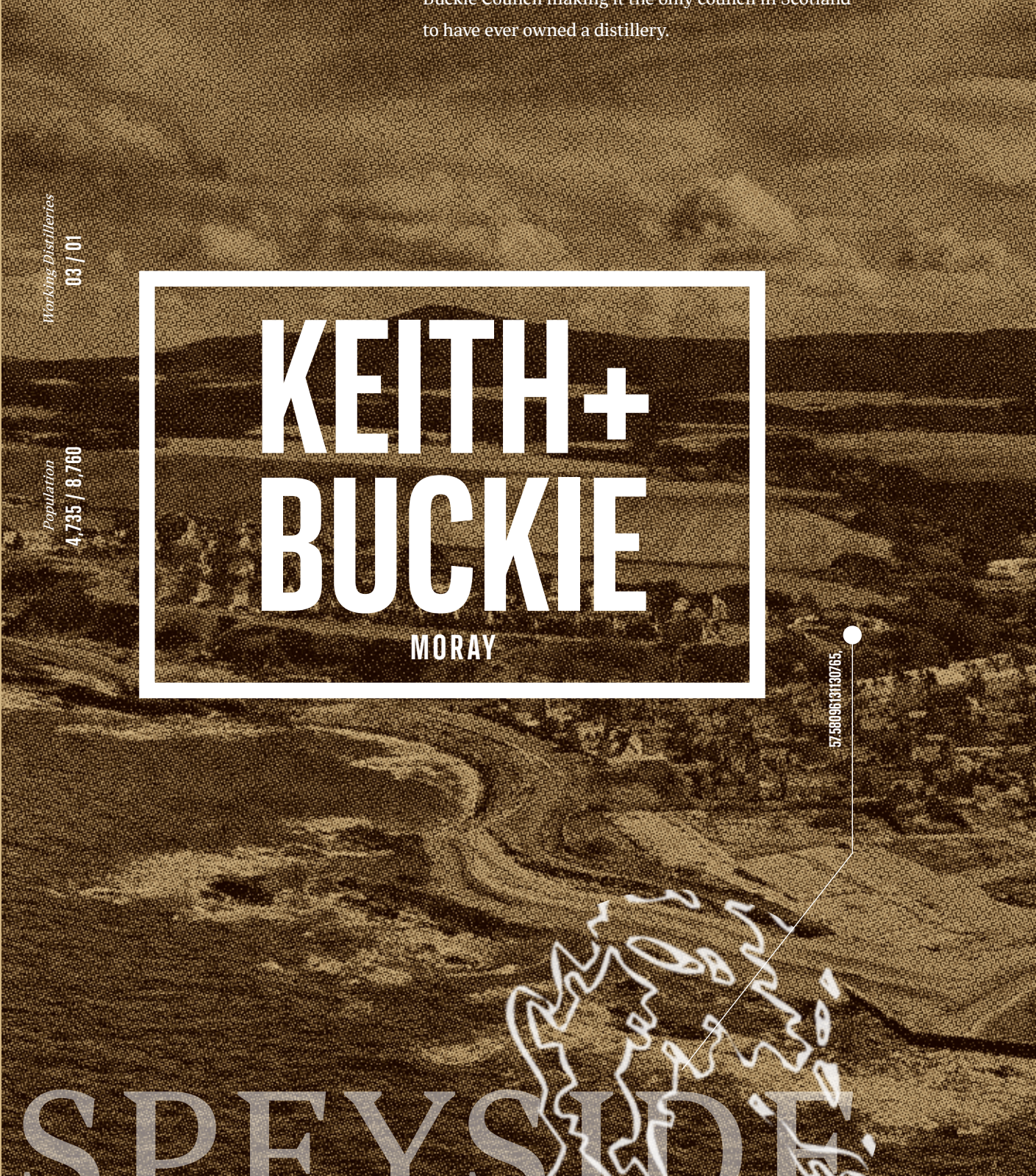

Keith is known as the friendly town but it is also an amalgamation of three smaller towns and the jury is still out on which one is the friendliest. Keith is considered to be the start of the Malt Whisky Trail and as such, leads to it being a very popular destination. You could, if you were on a tour, travel north ten miles and instead discover the quieter town of Buckie. Buckie is a wonderful Scottish coastal town and is mainly known for fishing. The town hosts Inchgower, a distillery that was formed using equipment from Tochineal, a lost Scotch whisky distillery. Inchgower was at one point purchased by Buckie Council making it the only council in Scotland to have ever owned a distillery.

It has great restaurants, excellent pubs, its own whisky shop and some of the best fishing spots in the country. Located right in the centre of Speyside, it is said that there are fifty distilleries within fifty miles. Just down the road is the slightly more 'real' town of Rothes. Here you will find three distilleries as well as a hotel with an incredible whisky bar built by the town's famous coppersmiths. These coppersmiths were the people responsible for maintaining and building a lot of Speyside's cathedrals of copper and used the same techniques and materials to make the bar.

Knockando is rural, situated smack in the middle of Speyside's farming region, this is barley country. For a relatively small town it is pretty well stocked on the distillery front. Not only this but it has a renowned woolen mill which has been producing fine material since the mid eighteenth century. When you are in this area its extremely easy to visualize the historic illicit still trade. Imagine local folk hiding small stills in and around the hills and glens that nurtured the birth of Scotch whisky. At the same time these enterprising distillers would have been running their stills, the Grant family would have been living in Ballindaloch Castle. The castle has been inhabited by the same family for over 450 years, known as the 'Pearl of the North' and even has a couple of distilleries on the grounds.

Port Ellen is one of two ports providing access into arguably the world's most famous whisky island. With nine working distilleries, producing iconic, bold and punchy styles of whisky, they have travelled the world and made the villages of Islay's names appear on famous bars the world over. Take, for example, Lagavulin, a small hamlet located on the craggy and beautiful south coast of Islay producing a smoky and rich single malt. Port Ellen also contains the famous ghost distillery with bottles fetching eye watering amounts of money in auction sites globally. Round the bay from the sleeping distillery are some of the great places to enjoy a dram on the island including the Carraig Fhada and the Singing Sands.

CARBOST SKYE

Skye has arguably the most beautiful landscapes in Scotland. On the way onto the island, you pass Eilean Donan, a castle known the world over from its roles in *Highlander* and *The World Is Not Enough*. The island itself is a collection of volcanic mountains that look like they have been formed by a prehistoric dinosaur that has run through, tearing bits off mountains and leaving jagged remains. Skye is one of the most visited island in Scotland and it is easy to see why. From the minute you get onto the island to Neist Point, the Islands most westerly point, all the way up to Rubha Hunish in the north, Skye is one jaw dropping vista after another. Located on the shores of Loch Harport is Talisker distillery a must see for any whisky visitor to Scotland. Grab a bottle of 10 year old and take a short walk up the hill to the Oyster Shed. Talisker and Oysters sums this wild island and really brings to life this iconic distillery described by many as “Made By The Sea”

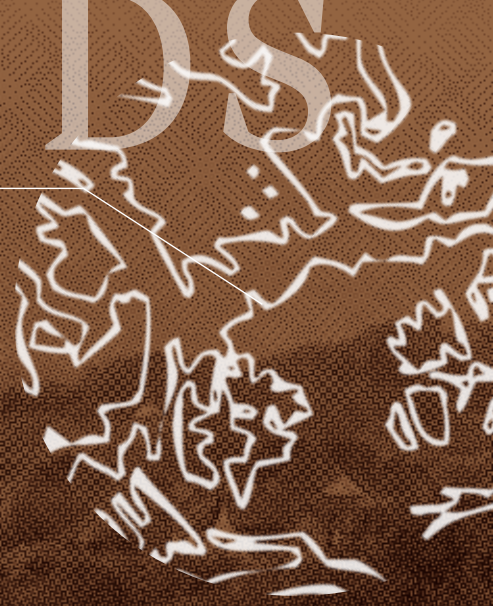

This small town in the north packs a punch when it comes to the whisky, industrial and football worlds. Brora's famous exports include coal, boats, salt, cured fish, lemonade and most famously whisky. Brora was the first place in the north of Scotland to have electricity thanks to its wool industry. This distinction gave rise to the local nickname of "Electric City". Along side all of this Brora is also home to the worlds most famous ghost distillery recently brought back from the dead to make whisky once again. Spooky!

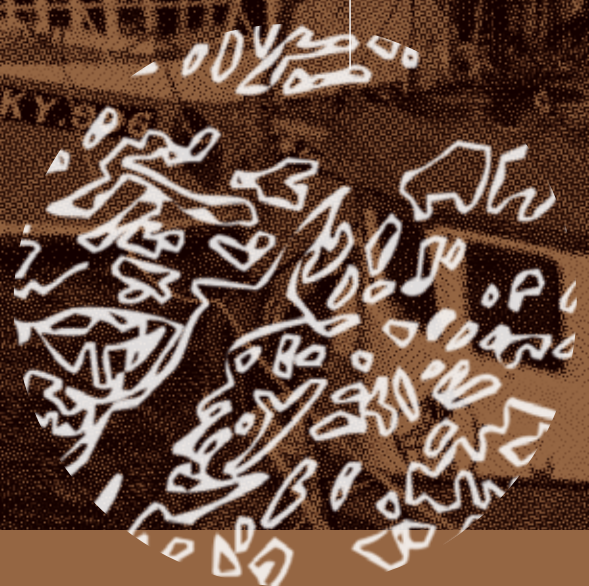
